



Mass. airport drafting 20-year master plan

Barnstable Municipal, Boardman/Polando Field in Hyannis, Mass., is developing a 20-year master plan, which is expected to consider the future effects of electric aviation and include potential improvements, such as expanding parking lots and aprons and adapting runways to adhere to Federal Aviation Administration standards. Due to the pandemic, the planning process will take place remotely, with draft documents and video presentations available on the airport's website and YouTube channel for community comments and input.
